



In parallel with the monitoring campaigns at the domus Casa Bellezza, in 2009, LAMBDA started the investigation into the Mitreo under the Church of Santa Prisca on the Aventine Hill in Rome.

This place dedicated to the Roman god Mithras is extraordinarily well preserved and is carefully monitored by the Superintendence for Archaeological Heritage of Rome.

It was decided to monitor this ancient pagan place of worship with data loggers for temperature and relative humidity and with probes for the measurement of carbon dioxide and light.
