

Palazzo Grassi

Palazzo Grassi is an eighteenth century palace built by the Grassi family, that's now an important location for international fame. Simultaneously with the renewal of the exhibition rooms, Palazzo Grassi in 2006 has a permanent system of monitoring of the exhibition spaces.

LAMBDA SpA has installed 47 of temperature and relative humidity sensors connected to the central data acquisition WireClimArt.

The sensors have been hidden in Ductwork thanks to the media created specifically for this site, minimizing the visual impact of the plant. The system is controlled by a computer located in the offices of the palace from which you can check the status of sensors and data management.
